Lesser long-nosed bats (*Leptonycteris curasoae*) pollinate agave and many species of southwestern cacti. They migrate from Mexico to the southern parts of Arizona and New Mexico. Lesser long-nosed bats were listed as an endangered species in 1988. Since then, their numbers have increased dramatically.
